## IN 2022:

- 100% DIAGNOSED WITH ONE OR MORE MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS
- 88% EXPERIENCED ABUSE IN THEIR PAST
- 68% HAD HISTORY OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE
- 69% OF OUR CLIENTS WERE MINORS
- 50% HAD NO PRIOR PRENATAL CARE BEFORE MOTHERS REFUGE
- 100% OF RESIDENTS FALL WELL BELOW THE FEDERAL POVERTY LINE

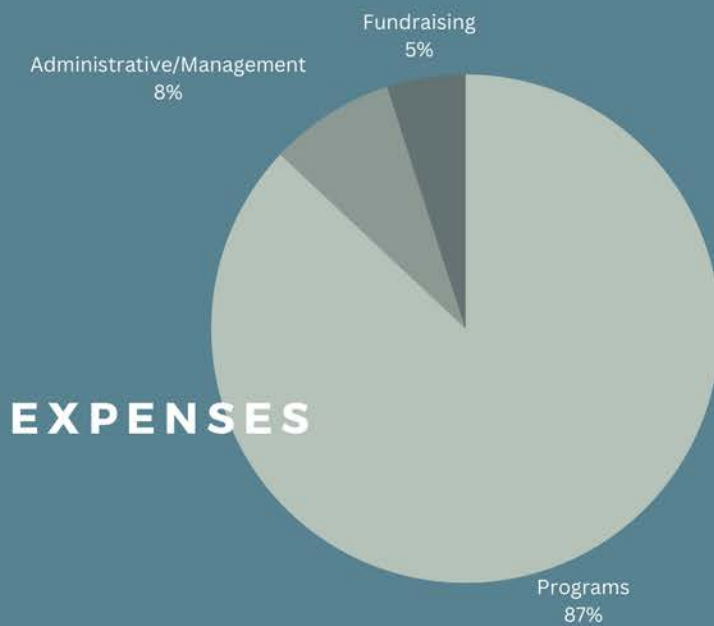
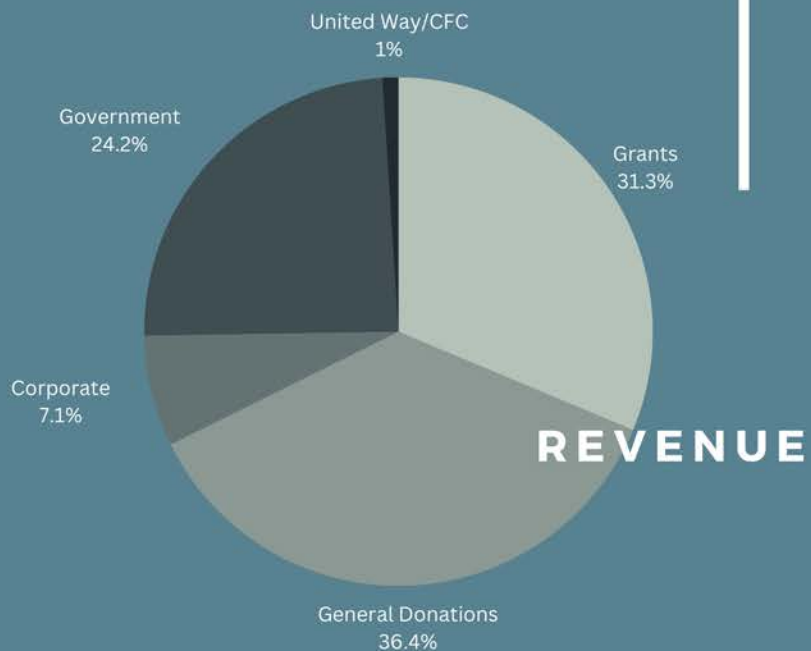

# HIGHER GROUND

Mother's Refuge had a very exciting year in 2022. In March, we launched our new Transitional Living Program (TLP) in response to a dire community need for affordable housing for young families. We started with four, 2-bedroom apartments for our TLP and were gifted a 3-bedroom house shortly after! In October, we had an incredible Night of Compassion Gala, raising \$365,000! Lastly, in December we purchased a building! Our new property was previously the Higher Ground Hotel, located at 200 N Delaware, in downtown Independence. When renovations are finished, it will have 15 individual apartments plus administrative offices, and a gathering space for our program graduates. Mother's Refuge is moving to higher ground, and will be able to serve more moms and babies than ever before. Join us in 2023 for another year fulfilling our mission!
